

Fingerless Gloves

Pattern/Tutorial

Age 3-6



What you will need:

- ★ Non-scratchy wool 8ply
- ★ Size 7 needles
- ★ Darning needle

Abbreviations: K (knit), P (purl)

I am not an experienced pattern maker so there may be confusion or errors. Any feedback is much appreciated.

You can make this pattern larger by casting on more stitches. Always remember to finish on an even number. To lengthen just add more rows in the ribbing and body part of the glove.

Step 1.

- ★ Cast on 36 stitches

Step 2 (ribbing).

Row 1: K1, P1 repeat to the end.

Row 2: K1, P1 repeat to the end.

Row 3-8: repeat above.



Step 3.

Row 9: K

Row 10: P

Row 11-24: repeat alternating rows above.



You can use one colour or multiple, choice is yours. My stripes are 4 rows high. Always finish the rows with the tails on one side only. Make sure these tails are long enough to sew up the side and then weave into the glove to finish.

Step 4.
Row 25-30: K
Row 31: Cast off.



(reverse side)

Step 5.

- ★ Fold in half with reverse side facing out. Using the darning needle stitch up from the bottom $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches up or 16 rows. I change the thread to match the rows, giving a cleaner finish.



- ★ Then from the top edge down stitch up 1 inch or 10 rows. This leaves just over an inch gap for the thumb to stick through.



- ★ Finish off by weaving in the loose threads and trimming off.



Turn right side and now you have some styling hand warmers.
